- Please submit an anonymous abstract of your paper (300 words in English OR 700 characters in Japanese) with the title (both in English AND Japanese). On a separate sheet, please provide your name, affiliation, position, e-mail address and telephone numbers (both work and personal). Also, please provide equipment needed (other than a projector and screen).
- Abstract Deadline: **Friday, December 11** (Send your abstract to: Teppei Kiyosue [[kiyosue.2@osu.edu](mailto:kiyosue.2@osu.edu)]). Please write "CATJ Proposal" on the subject line. (Notification via e-mail by Monday, January 11)
- Papers presented, with revisions made after the conference, will be published in a Conference Proceedings volume as well as online.
