Observance of COVID-19 Health and Safety Measures

- All the test takers must submit **a hard copy (print-out) of their vaccination card, or their negative COVID-19 test result** at the time of check in.
- Only test takers are allowed on campus. **Guests who accompany you to the test site are not allowed on campus.**
- You **must comply** with any **health and safety measures** (for example, **wearing a face mask** and sanitizing your hands).
- You will be refused entry to sit for the Test and asked to leave the Test venue if you do not comply with such health and safety measures. In that event, you will be deemed to have forfeited any Test fee that you have paid.

If you are feeling unwell on the Test Day

- If you have any symptoms of COVID-19 (for example coughing, sore throat, high fever and/or headache) on the Test Day, you should not attend the Test.
- The Host Institution reserves the right to refuse you from sitting the exam at its absolute discretion, if you are reasonably suspected to have such symptoms of COVID-19. In that event, you will be deemed to have forfeited any Test fee that you have paid.

Reporting Time and Test Schedule:

- Please access the campus **ONLY from Gate 1.** (See the attached map.) You will be asked to show your ID and the proof of vaccination or negative test result at the gate. Please check in between **11:30am-12:00pm.**
- Once you are on campus, report to your assigned classroom in Carman Hall during the scheduled reporting time. You must present your **admission voucher** (print out), proper **photo identification**, and **proof of vaccination (print out) or a negative COVID test** to a proctor in order to be allowed into the classroom.
- Since the test takes place during winter when severe weather could affect roads and public transportation, please make sure you allow for extra time to reach the test site as well as to return to your destination.

General Testing Guidelines:

- Dress so that you can adapt to any room temperature.
- Guests who accompany you to the test center are not allowed in the classroom.
- You are not allowed to leave the test room until a proctor dismisses you. If you get sick during the test and must leave the room, you must notify the proctor so that the proctor can accompany you out of the room.

What to Bring to the Test Site:

You **MUST** bring the following items to the test site.

1. Your **hard copy (print-out) of your vaccination card** or **hard copy (print-out) of negative COVID19 test result**.
2. **MASKS:** You are required to mask regardless of your vaccination status.
3. Your **admission voucher**.
4. A **valid form of photo ID**. Copies are not accepted.
 - Acceptable forms of official identification include driver's license, passport, or student ID. Social security cards, credit or ATM cards, and retail credit cards are not acceptable.
 - The name on your voucher must match the name on the official ID that you bring to the test center.
 - It is your responsibility to ensure that your official ID is valid and available on the day of the test.
 - ID checks are strictly enforced. If you arrive at the test center without a valid ID, you will not be permitted to take the test.
5. Several sharpened No. 2 or HB **pencils** and an **eraser** for multiple-choice answer sheets. Pencils and erasers will not be supplied at the test center.
6. An analog watch. (We do not provide a clock in the classroom.)
Do NOT bring a watch that beeps. Digital watches are not allowed. You cannot use your cell phones as a timepiece.

Prohibited Materials: Do Not Bring the Following Items to the Test Site:

1. Electronic devices or media such as tablets, laptops, or any other recording devices.
2. A watch that beeps or has an alarm.
3. Handwritten or printed materials.
4. Food or drinks, except water in a clear bottle with no label and with a secure lid.
The water bottle must be stored in your bag under your seat, not on your desk, during the test.
5. Cell phones
All cell phones must be **completely turned off** and stored during the test. If your phone makes any noise for whatever reason, including incoming calls, vibrate mode, accidents, etc., we will **void your test score** and you will not receive a score for the test.

Lehman College is located on Bedford Park Boulevard West and Goulden Avenue in a residential area in the northwest Bronx, south of Van Cortlandt Park and west of the New York Botanical Garden-near the border of Westchester County. The campus is situated between the Kingsbridge and Bedford Park neighborhoods, along the historic Jerome Park Reservoir.

By Car:

From Manhattan - East Side

Via East River Drive to Willis Avenue Bridge (or Triborough Bridge- known officially as the Robert F. Kennedy Bridge - Bronx spur) to Major Deegan Expressway (I-87) north to Van Cortlandt Park South exit. Follow directions from the Major Deegan Expressway.

From Manhattan - West Side

Via West Side Highway north (it becomes Henry Hudson Parkway) to Mosholu Parkway exit. Follow directions from the Henry Hudson Parkway.

From Westchester

- Via **New York State Thruway (I-87) south** (it becomes Major Deegan Expressway) to Van Cortlandt Park South exit. Follow directions from the Major Deegan Expressway.
- Via **Saw Mill River Parkway south** (it becomes Henry Hudson Parkway) to Mosholu Parkway exit. Follow directions from the Henry Hudson Parkway.
- Via **Bronx River Parkway south** to Gun Hill Road exit. Make a right from exit ramp and take Gun Hill Road West to Jerome Avenue. Turn left onto Jerome, following the elevated subway line above to W. 205 Street. Turn right, and proceed two short blocks to Goulden Avenue. Make a left onto Goulden Avenue and proceed one block. Campus is on the left.

From Queens and Eastern Long Island

- Via **Grand Central Parkway to Triborough Bridge** (known officially as the Robert F. Kennedy Bridge) - Bronx spur to Major Deegan Expressway (I-87) north to Van Cortlandt Park South exit. Follow directions from the Major Deegan Expressway.
- Via **Throgs Neck Bridge or Whitestone Bridge** to Cross Bronx Expressway west to Major Deegan Expressway (I-87) north to Van Cortlandt Park South exit. Follow directions from the Major Deegan Expressway.

From New Jersey

Via George Washington Bridge to Major Deegan Expressway (I-87) north to Van Cortlandt Park South exit. Follow directions from the Major Deegan Expressway.

From the Major Deegan Expressway

Exit at Van Cortlandt Park South. From the south, bear left along the fork of the exit ramp and make a left at the traffic light. From the north, make a left at the traffic light. Proceed up the winding hill for 4 traffic lights. Immediately after 4th traffic light, make a quick right onto Goulden Avenue. Proceed two long blocks to Bedford Park Boulevard West, where the campus begins. The parking lot is on your right.

From the Henry Hudson Parkway

Exit at Mosholu Parkway. Proceed on long exit ramp. At the second traffic light, before subway underpass, turn right onto Paul Avenue for two long blocks. At Bedford Park Boulevard, turn right and then left onto Goulden Avenue. The parking lot is on your right.

By Public Transportation:**By Train**

IRT No. 4 or the IND "D" line to Kingsbridge Road. The campus is a five-minute walk. From the train station on Kingsbridge Road and Jerome Avenue, walk one block to the north to West 195th street, turn left on West 195th street, and walk one block to Goulden Ave. Turn right onto Goulden Ave. Walk one block to the north and enter the campus from Gate 1. For more information about subway service to the Lehman campus, call the New York City Transit Authority at (718) 330-1234. Metro North's Harlem line has a local stop at the Botanical Gardens station. Call Metro North for information about fares and schedules (212) 532-4900.

By Bus

Nine Bronx buses including the 2, 10, 22, and 28 have stops at Lehman College. Liberty Lines BXM4A or 4B express buses from Manhattan stop near the campus, at Bedford Park Boulevard and the Grand Concourse. Good connections are available on Westchester 20 or 20X buses from White Plains, Hartsdale, Scarsdale, and Yonkers via Central Park Avenue. The No. 4 from Yonkers also stops near the campus. For more information about taking a bus to the Lehman campus, call (718) 330-1234 (Bronx buses) or (718) 652-8400 (Liberty Lines) or (914) 682-2020 (Westchester buses).

Parking:

Examinees may park in the Parking Lot (South Lot) on Goulden Avenue from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm. You will be allowed to enter the lot between 11am-12:30pm.

Parking Fee: \$10

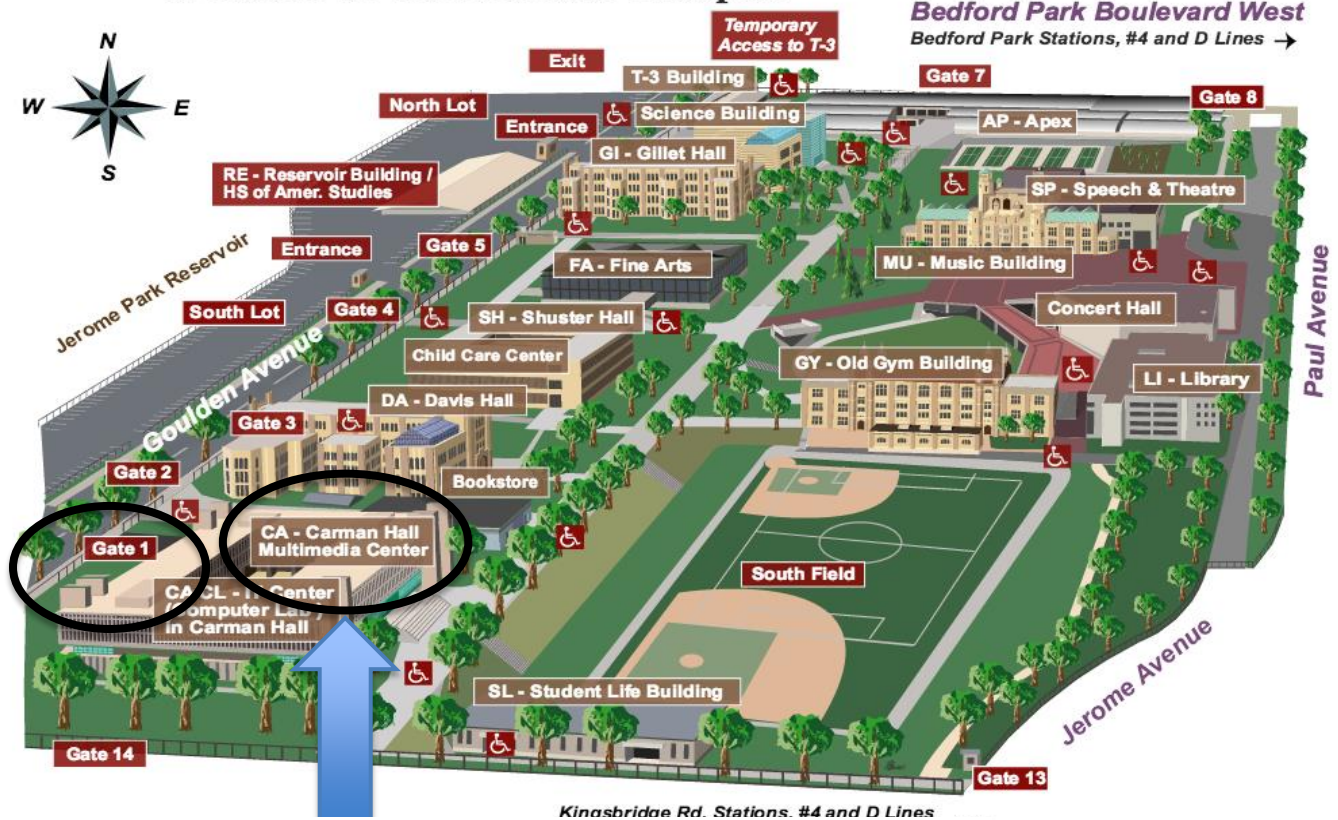
