# What to Bring to the Test Site:

You **MUST** bring the following items to the test site.

- 1. **A mask.** Masks are not required in indoor spaces on campus. However, we will continue to be a mask-friendly campus and wearing a mask will be highly recommended for all indoor spaces.
- 2. Your admission voucher (print-out).
- 3. A valid form of photo ID. Copies are not accepted.
  - Acceptable forms of official identification include driver's license, passport, or student ID. Social security cards, credit or ATM cards, and retail credit cards are not acceptable.
  - The name on your voucher must match the name on your official ID that you bring to the test center.
  - It is your responsibility to ensure that your official ID is valid and available on the day of the test.

- ID checks are strictly enforced. If you arrive at the test center without a valid ID, you will not be permitted to take the test.
- 4. Several sharpened No. 2 or HB **pencils** and an **eraser** for multiple-choice answer sheets. Pencils and erasers will not be supplied at the test center. Pens are NOT permitted.
- An analog watch
  Do NOT bring a watch that beeps. You cannot use your cell phone as a timepiece.

## **Prohibited Materials:**

Do Not Bring the Following Items to the Test Site:

- Electronic equipment, including cell phones of any kind; personal computing devices (laptops, notebooks, Bluetooth devices such as wireless earbuds/headphones, or tablets); cameras; separate timers of any kind; audio players/recorders or headphones; wearable technology; digital watches, including smartwatches; or any other prohibited devices that can be used to record, transmit, or receive information.
  - All cell phones and other devices described above must be completely turned off and stored in your bag under your seat during the test. If your device makes any noise for whatever reason, including incoming calls, vibrate mode, accidents, etc., we will void your test score and you will not receive a score for the test.
- 2. Handwritten or printed materials.
  - cheat sheets written on paper, Japanese characters on skin, clothing and personal belongings.
- Food or drinks, except water in a clear bottle with no label and with a secure lid.
  The water bottle must be stored in your bag under your seat, not on your desk, during the test.

**Note**: If you are traveling from a distance and have any prohibited items or a travel bag with you, you must leave your belongings with a proctor at your designated classroom during the test. Your personal bag should be kept under your seat and should not block any walkways.

#### General Testing Guidelines:

- Dress so that you can adapt to any room temperature.
- Guests who accompany you to the test site are not allowed in the classroom.
- You are not allowed to leave the test room until a proctor dismisses you. If you get sick during the test and must leave the room, you must notify the proctor so that the proctor can accompany you out of the room.

# By Car

# From the north and northwest:

From the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn left (east.) The Lincoln Park campus is approximately two miles from the expressway on Fullerton Avenue at Kenmore Avenue.

### From the west:

From the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290), turn onto the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) heading toward Wisconsin. From the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn right (east.) The Lincoln Park campus is approximately two miles from the expressway on Fullerton Avenue at Kenmore Avenue.

### From the south:

From the Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/I-94) continue as the expressway becomes the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94). Exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn right (east.) The Lincoln Park campus is approximately two miles from the expressway on Fullerton Avenue at Kenmore Avenue.

From Lake Shore Drive (north or south) Exit Lake Shore Drive at Fullerton Avenue. Head west for approximately three miles. The Lincoln Park campus is located on Fullerton Avenue at Kenmore Avenue.

# By Public Transportation

# Rapid Transit Lines:

Three rapid transit train lines service the Lincoln Park area and DePaul's Lincoln Park campus. Exit at the Fullerton station. After coming down the steps, turn left (west) and walk two blocks to Kenmore Avenue. These are the train lines servicing the Lincoln Park campus:

- Howard/Dan Ryan (Red)
- Evanston Express (Purple)
- Ravenswood (Brown)

You may transfer to these lines from all other train lines in most downtown stations.

# Buses:

Bus routes interconnect throughout the city. Several buses stop very near the Lincoln Park campus. All routes are subject to change by the CTA.
